October

Human Body:

- **2.** Giving names to body functions
- 3. Discuss Halloween, what it is, how we celebrate, and discuss typical Halloween traditions.

Science:

- Exploring pumpkins and gourds
- Cleaning out the inside of a pumpkin

Arts and Crafts:

- Making paper Jack-o-lanterns using different cut out shapes
- Painting mini pumpkins
- Making paper plate faces

November

Weather:

- 1. Introducing weather (sunny, cloudy, rainy, etc.)
- 2. Naming the weather of the day and discuss appropriate outdoor clothing
- 3. Introduce the weather song

- Stereognostic bags

Science:

Making a shaving cream rain cloud

- Making a paper cut out sun

December

Winter:

- 1. Introducing winter: weather, colours, clothes we wear.
- 2. Discuss snow: texture, colour, temperature.
- 3. Discuss winter activities.
- **4.** Discuss holidays that are celebrated during winter in the month of December: Christmas, Hanukkah and Kwanzaa.

- Snow shoveling

Science:

- Freezing tinted water
- Melting tinted ice cubes
- Melting snow

- Painting snow
- Holiday craft

<u>January</u>

Five Senses:

- 1. Talk about the five senses: what they are, what they do.
- 2. Use smelling jars during circle time (sense of smell)
- 3. Play with pinwheels (sense of sight)
- 4. Texture board during circle time (sense of touch)
- 5. Listening to the noise outdoors and naming the sounds (sense of hearing)
- 6. Eating oranges (sense of taste)

Montessori Activities:

- Matching Colours
- Playing with mini mirror (making faces, exploring features)
- Stereognostic bag
- 5 senses themed language cards

Science:

Making and explore goop

- Free painting using painting brushes and tempera paints
- Make mini earths for earth day using paper plates and tissue paper
- Making multicoloured tissue paper collage

February

Community Helpers:

- 1. Introducing Community Helpers, what are they, who are they, what they do, how they help.
- **2.** Discuss emergency community helpers, example: police officers, fire fighters, doctors.
- **3.** Discuss service community helpers, example: Librarian, mail courier, bus driver, dentist.
- **4.** Discuss Valentines day, what it is, how we celebrate, colours and shape.

Science:

March

- 2. Talk about gardening.
- 3. Plant and take care of seedlings
- 4. Care for outdoor playground

- Flower arranging

Science:

• Planting seeds and caring for plant

- Painting with flowers.
- Gluing together paper flowers
- Making a spring collage

April

Insects/Frogs:

- 1. Introduction to insects and frogs: discussing them, naming them, introducing photos of insects/ frogs
- 2. Looking at the life cycle of a frog as well as butterfly
- 3. Spotting insects in playground

Under the sea:

- 1. Introducing underwater wildlife

- **3.** Talk about Mother's Day: what it is, who its for, why we celebrate, talk about our mothers.
